

**Ada County 4-H Endowment Fund, Inc.
College Scholarship Application**

The Ada County Endowment Fund, Inc. Scholarship Foundation has been established to recognize outstanding 4-H'ers in Ada County who wish to further their education and use the skills they gained in the 4-H program. Each year one 4-H'er will be awarded the scholarship to assist in attending a college or post-secondary school of his or her choice.

Eligibility

1. Must be currently enrolled and participating in the Ada County 4-H program.
2. Must be a graduating senior in good standing in any Ada County school.
3. Must submit application prior to posted deadline.
4. Must be accepted as a full time student at a college or post-secondary school.

Payment of Scholarship

1. Award will be paid directly to the school attended by the recipient.
2. If the nominee has not yet selected a college, nominee must notify the Ada County 4-H Endowment Fund, Inc of his or her choice by August 1.

GUIDELINES FOR EVALUATION OF COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

In all selections, there should be evidence of achievement toward the objectives of the scholarship program as outlined in the scholarship information sheet.

1. Personal Growth and Development Through 4-H – 10 Points

As shown by growth of experiences in project work

2. Experiences in Communications – 10 Points

As shown by talks, demonstrations, presentations, displays, news stories, etc.

3. Experiences in Leadership – 20 Points

As shown by leadership participation experiences; offices held; committee assignments and responsibilities accepted in club, county and state experiences. Also by participation in leadership experiences, offices held in other youth organizations, community, church, and school with emphasis on how 4-H experiences have helped with these experiences.

4. Experiences in Citizenship and Community Service – 20 Points

As shown by development of positive attitudes toward service to individuals, groups and the community; participation in citizenship and community service activities. Also by participation in community service activities in other youth organizations, community, church, and school with emphasis on how 4-H involvement has helped with these experiences.

5. 4-H Achievement Story – 40 Points

As shown by new knowledge, attitudes, and skills learned; scope and characteristics of projects and activities; project and activity participation experiences; development of life skills; and sharing information with others.
