 5. When excused, complete a 3/4 (270°) pivot and trot past A.



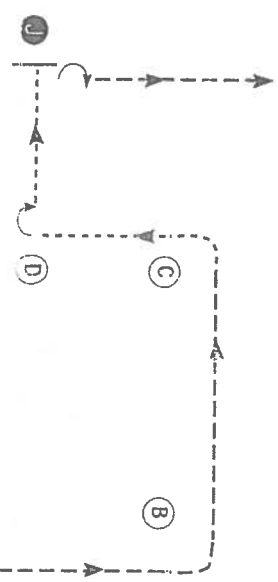
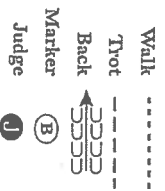

1. Walk from A and stop with the horse's hind quarters centered between cones C & D
 2. Perform a 360° turn to the right on the hind quarters.
 3. Trot around cone B as shown
 4. Continue trotting around cone D as shown.
 5. Stop when the horse's nose is in line with cone A.
 6. Back five (5) steps
 7. Perform a 1/2 (270°) turn.
 8. Walk as diagramed until the hind quarters of the horse are in line with the Judge.
 9. Perform a 1/2 (90°) turn.
 10. Stop and set-up for inspection.
 11. When dismissed, push the horse slightly right, walk past judge, perform a 3/4 (90°) turn and trot away.

6. Stop and set up for inspection.
7. When dismissed, perform a 1/4 turn.
8. Back approximately one horse length.
9. Perform a 1/2 turn and walk straight away to exit.

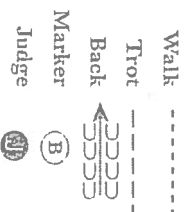

 5. Stop and perform a 180 degree turn to the right on the hindquarter
 6. Jog a circle back to B
 7. Stop at B
- Follow instructions of ring steward



WALK TROT PATTERNS



1. Walk to cone A
 2. Pivot 360 haunch turn left
 3. Jog circle around cone C
 4. Jog 3/4 circle around cone B
 5. Continue at jog cone D, stop and back a horse length
 6. Exit to line at a walk
- Follow instructions of ring steward
