C. Contribution to Science

- Ms. Morrisroe-Aman is a member of the Cooperative Extension National Diabetes Prevention Program collaborative. She worked with a multi-state team to develop and deliver professional training, present at national and international conferences, co-authored articles and contributed to research on the Extension Diabetes Prevention Programs.
- Ms. Morrisroe-Aman worked with a team of extension educators and food safety specialist to develop a water bottle safety research study on the cleaning practices of middle school youth. Following the study she was the lead author on a journal article and an Extension Bulletin "H20 to Go: Staying Hydrated Safely!" that included an infographic for youth on how to safely clean and use reusable water bottles.
- Ms. Morrisroe-Aman worked with a team of extension educators and coordinators to research and conduct a cost-benefit analysis of the Eat Smart Idaho (SNAP-ed) program. She studied the participation rates and barriers, for older adults in the U.S. and Idaho, in nutrition assistance programs for her master's research project. Additionally, in her graduate practicum with the Idaho Hunger Relief Taskforce, she worked with a
